HOW TO ENTER:

- Print off both forms from Fair website (Entry Form & Consent Form) and bring already filled out with you day of contest.
- Bring \$10 Cash or Money Order made payable to: Macon County Fair.
- It is NOT required to register in advance ---Registration will take place beginning at 5:00 pm under the Grandstand.
- **Contest starts at 6:00 p.m.**
- **Admission for those who wish to watch the contest is \$1 for those 12 and over.**

 Baby Miss: 6---11 months
 Tiny Miss: 1 year old
 Tiny Tot Miss: 2 year old
 Petite Miss: 3 year old

Infant Mister: 0---5 months
 Baby Mister: 6---11 months
 Tiny Mister: 1 year old
 Tiny Tot Mister: 2 year old
 Petite Mister: 3 year old

1. Applicants must select the appropriate group based on their gender and age on the day of the event. Last year's winners may only compete in the next age division. Last year's winners are not allowed to compete again for their current title if they remain in the same age division.
2. Girls and Boys will compete separately.
3. The Fair reserves the right to see proof of age (birth certificate) upon request.
4. An entry fee of \$10.00 must accompany entry form. NO REFUNDS will be given. The entry fee will also allow 1 parent/guardian to accompany child. Additional guests will be \$1/Admission for those 12 years of age and older.
5. Every participant will receive a Certificate of Participation.
6. 1st place Winners in each division will receive a trophy.
7. Entry forms are available on the Macon County Fair web site www.maconcountyfair.com.
8. Pageant attire is not necessary and is not preferred. Makeup is not allowed.
9. Each child will be accompanied on stage by one adult (parent/guardian) and come to the center of the stage. At this time, your child should smile, be cute, show personality, charm the judges, etc.
10. This contest is for "fun" only. The children will in no way represent the Macon County Fairgrounds Festival at other functions displaying the title, Adorable Baby Contest Winner.
11. Parents/Guardians agree that the judge's decision is final.
