1. All Culinary Entries are due by Tuesday, June 2. Please use entry form and abide by all deadlines.
2. Check-in is Wednesday, June 3 at AG Expo Building.
3. All entries will be picked up on Sunday, June 7 from 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm. All premiums will be mailed.
4. Exhibits of canned food must have been prepared after July, 1st of last year.
5. All canned products must be shown in size containers indicated and plainly labeled.
6. Canned fruits, vegetables and meats will not be opened unless questionable.
7. All other cans of preserved food may be opened and attested at the discretion of the judge.
8. Exhibitors are limited to two exhibits in each entry number. Do not enter previous prize winning canned goods.
9. A “display” cannot be made up of single entries.
10.  $\frac{3}{4}$  of each pie and cake may be removed after judging. Those not taken on day of judging must remain until end of fair.
11. **Entries and Ribbons MUST be picked up on Sunday June 7th, 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm.**
12. No mixes or pre-packaged items allowed. All baked goods from scratch.
13. During Judging, the department will be closed to exhibitors and spectators.
14. Please be sure your name is marked on pie plates or containers.
15. Diabetic entries should be labeled diabetic.
16. Jelly must be in sealed jars.
